American Attitudes toward American Domestic Politics

Survey Methodology

The survey was carried out August 18-28, 2020 online from a nationally representative sample of Nielsen Scarborough's probability-based panel, originally recruited by mail and telephone using a random sample of adults. The national poll was conducted among 3,932 respondents, with a margin of error of +/- 1.56%. Overall, the sample was adjusted to reflect population estimates (Scarborough USA+/Gallup) for Americans. The survey variables balanced through weighting were: age, gender, race/ethnicity, household income, level of education, census regional division, and political party affiliation.

In addition to the national sample, we also divided the respondents into two groups, one for the first six days before the Republican Convention and spanning the Democratic Convention (August 18-23, 2020), and the second for the last five days spanning the Republican Convention and the day after (August 24-28, 2020). Each group was independently adjusted by the same demographic variables to reflect population estimates.

The margin of error for the first group is +/- 2.09% (2,208 respondents) and the margin of error for the second group is +/- 2.36% (1,724 respondents).

Note: These questions were fielded as part of a larger poll on foreign and domestic issues. Participants in this study were provided by Nielsen from Nielsen's sample of respondents.

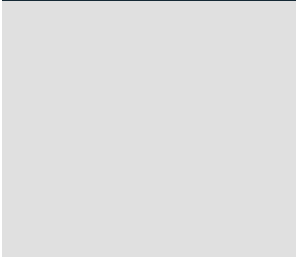
